Guidelines:

Point range indicates the maximum amount of points that evaluator can allocate to each category. For instance, a candidate with a 3.8 GPA would get more points out of the possible 10 than a candidate with a 3.0 GPA. Someone with several extra-curricular activities would get 5 points and someone with no extra-curricular activities wouldn't get any points. The scale places the most emphasis on the quality of the essay that is submitted, which is consistent with the history of this award. However, when all the entries are good, it is helpful to have less subjective criteria to help select the recipient.
